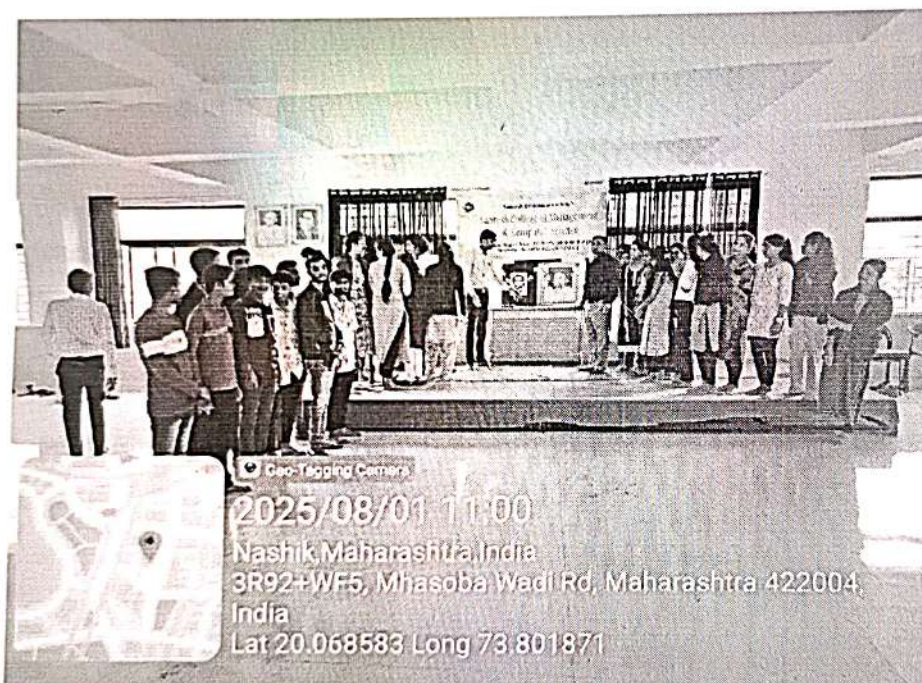
4. Speech by Staff Member:
